



SAS[®] Event Stream Manager 5.1: Renewal Instructions

Renewing Your Software License

A valid license file is required to run SAS Event Stream Manager. The following instructions explain how to replace an existing license file that has expired, or is about to expire, with a new license file.

Your Software Order Email contained a license file that you were instructed to save. Now you must apply this new license file to the local machine by saving it to the default license directory.

Note: The default license directory already contains a file named `license.txt`. This is the existing license file, which will be replaced by the new license file.

- 1 Locate the new license file that you previously saved.
- 2 Copy the new license file into the default license directory and rename it `license.txt`. Use the command shown here. In the command, substitute *license-filename* with the filename of the new license file that you saved to your computer.

```
sudo cp license-filename /opt/sas/viya/config/etc/sysconfig/sas-esm-service/default/license.txt
```

- 3 Restart the SAS Event Stream Manager service. Run the following command:

```
sudo service sas-viya-esm-service-default restart
```

The service takes a few seconds to restart.
